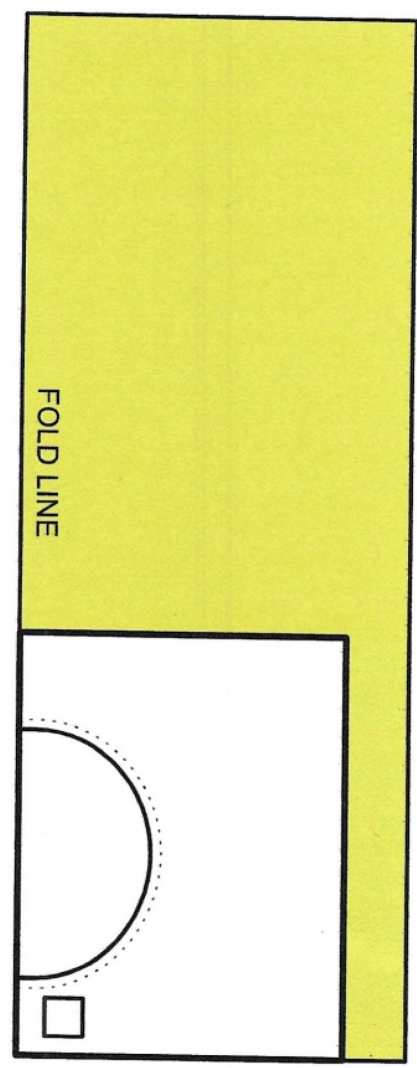
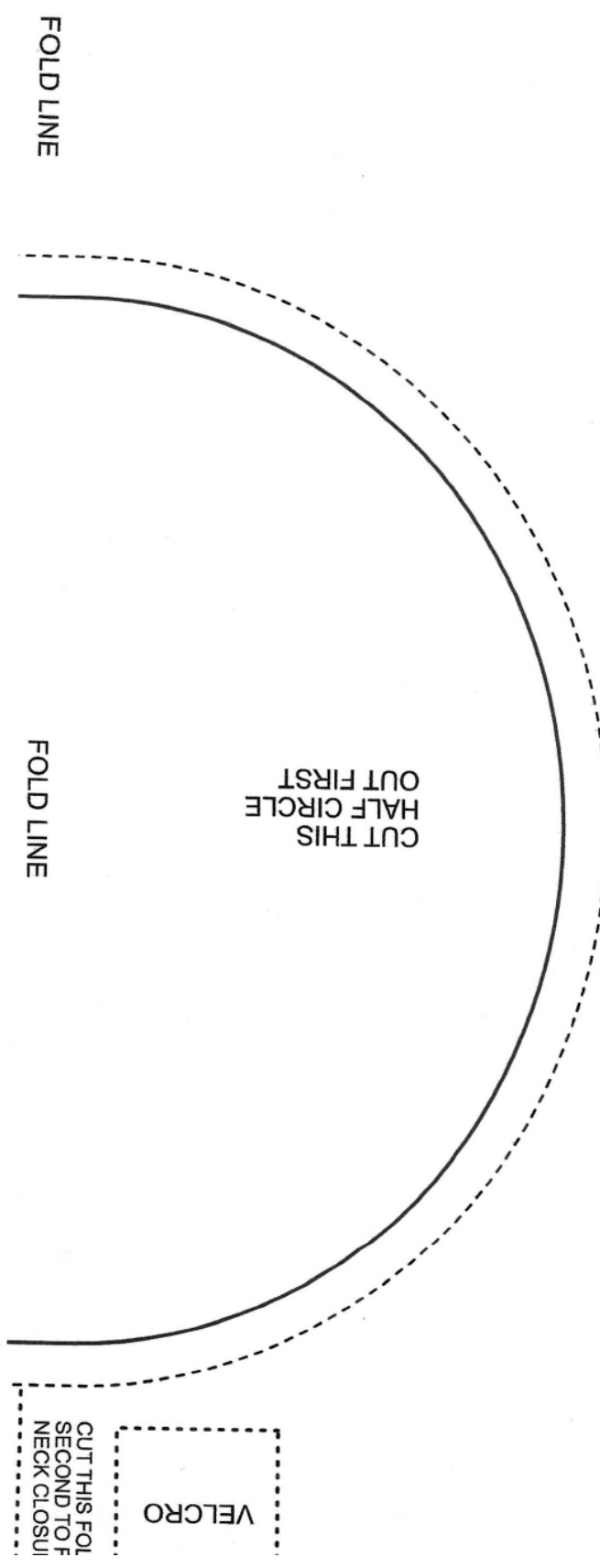


Adult Bib Pattern

Directions provided by Nancy Miller

- Layer the bib, the size is approximately 18" x 33". Quilt as you wish. Grid quilting would be one way to finish this project. Your choice in finishing the bib.
- Fold the material in half into a rectangle. At the fold center, place the pattern on material and pin.
- Cut down about 1 ½" as the picture shows. Then cut out the half circle for the neck opening. Trim the bottom corners, round the corners off.
- Trim the neck flaps and round them off also.
- Cut bias binding long enough to finish around the outer and inner neck opening and sew the binding on to the bib.
- Cut 1 ½" of Velcro (using the sew-in type) and sew onto the neck opening ends. I believe Velcro is a name brand product, [lease use any type you may have on hand.
- There are 9 women currently living at the Texas State Clyde Cospers Veterans Home out of the 160 people living in the facility.
- The suggestion for fabric was for no florals and themed fabrics. Exception for super hero fabric.
